SENIORS who fail a required course MUST make it up in order to graduate. Check with your child's counselor if you have any concerns.



National Honor Society Guidelines:

Students are eligible for National Honor Society if they have a cumulative average of 87% in their classes AND are in the top 20% of their class.



Students who are academically eligible are then evaluated on the basis of service, leadership and character.

Students who are not eligible as juniors can be looked at for induction during their senior year as well.

All students who will seek postgraduate education should file the FAFSA—the Free Application for Federal Student Aid — online at www.fafsa.ed.gov As of this year, the FAFSA can now be filed as of October 1st each year. This change is to help students & parents get a more accurate idea of what each college will cost when they get their acceptance package.

You will need an FSA ID to file and can create one here: https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/fafsa/filling-out/fsaid This same FSA ID will be used each year to fill out and file the FAFSA so keep it in a safe place!

SAT/ACT Score Sending

Please remember that your SAT and/or ACT scores must be sent electronically to schools you are applying to for admission.

This must be done at least 2 weeks before the application deadline. This needs to be done through collegeboard.org or ACTstudent.org Colleges do NOT accept SAT/ACT scores from us or

self reported by you on the CommonApp.
