The Project Topic

- Must include a "learning stretch"
- Explore:
 - Careers/Post-graduation plans
 - Something you have never done take a chance!
 - Something you have done, but want to take to a higher level challenge yourself!

Mentor

- Must be someone who has the expertise or experience to help you complete your learning stretch
- Mentoring can be in-person, remote, or a combination depending on your project
- Must have or get a state <u>criminal</u> <u>background check</u> (BCI)

Research Paper

- Connected to Senior Project topic

 This is NOT a report.
- This is a research-based position paper:
 - Take a position
 - Support it with evidence from your research
 - You know the structure from your Junior Research Paper.

Product

Product = Evidence of Learning Stretch

You must show how you created the product from start to finish.

Document the Process!!

 Documentation of the entire Senior Project Process

Series of artifacts showing your journey

Build it as you go; don't wait until the end!!


Portfolio
